Welcome to Wheaten Health Month at Pine Grove Animal Hospital. We've provided this wellness screening for the GDSCWTC for over 10 years. Our goal is to provide you with health screening information that will help you maintain a high quality of life for your Wheaten for many years to come. (If you are not a current client, we ask that you provide us with your vet's contact information so we can share results of our exam and testing.)

Your visit today will include the following:

- Medical history that will cover issues including diet, attitude, activity, coughing, sneezing, vomiting, diarrhea, thirst and urine output, mobility, seizures, pain, and scratching.
- Physical examination that will include temperature, pulse, respiration, and full physical examination.
- Collection of blood and urine for a Wheaten Profile including a 25-parameter biochemical panel, complete blood count with standard cbc, urinalysis, and urine protein/creatinine (UPC) ratio.
- Information on Genetic Testing for PLN-Associated Variant Genes.
- Heartworm test upon request.
- Thyroid test upon request or recommendation.

A few notes about your appointment day:

- A fasting blood collection is recommended, but not required. If you fast your Wheaten, a 12-hour fast is best.
- Since a portion of the testing requires a urine sample, we have a few options:
 - Bring a urine sample with you – we recommend that it is less than 6 hours old and refrigerated.
 - Do not allow your Wheaten to urinate for 1-2 hours prior to his or her appointment time and we can collect it when you arrive.
 - If you are worried that your Wheaten will urinate before you can get them in the hospital door – please call us when you arrive, and a nurse will be happy to meet you at your car to assist with urine collection.
 - If urine cannot be collected the day of the appointment, we have 30 days to submit a sample for no additional charge.
